

Sam Tsui of Orchid Inn on the topic of Parvi and Their Culture

Our next Orchid Society Meeting is June 17th 2014 at 7 pm at Cheekwood Botanical Gardens. Refreshments and plant preview will be at 6:30. Our speaker is Sam Tsui of Orchid Inn and he will be presenting the topic of Parvi and Their Culture.

Sam started growing orchids in the early 1980's and it has always been our passion! He started breeding/hybridizing in the early 1990's and eventually started our home-commercial business "Orchid Inn" in our basement and greenhouses attached to our house. As the business grows, we purchased a six acres property and built our first commercial 6,000 square greenhouse in 2004.

In the past 20 years, Sam has been very active in the orchid world, traveling for shows, sales, and lecturing. At Orchid Inn, Ltd, we continue to specialize in Paphiopedilums and Phragmipediums. We particularly emphasize species, Brachypetalum, Parvisepalum and Multifloral hybrids. We only select the best, most vigorous parent plants in our collection for breeding/hybridizing. Occasionally, we select the best plants or flasks which are, we believe, outstanding example of their type from our friends around the world to improve our breeding stock.

As a result of Orchid Inn breeding program, over two hundred American Orchid Society, Cymbidium Society of America and European Orchid Congress awards have been bestowed on our orchids. Our most prestigious awards include thirteen FCC/AOS awards, a 93 points CCE/AOS award, and seven AQ/AOS awards. Sam's goal is to offer you quality plants at a reasonable price. We also offer good quality and large quantity of Paphiopedilums and Phragmipediums species and hybrids in flask. We currently produce 4,000 to 5,000 flasks or approximately 100.000 seedlings annually. **Cheekwood** is located at 1200 Forrest Park Drive, Nashville, TN.
